Areas of interest

Poster presentations include, but are not limited to, the following topics:

ETS methodology towards a comprehensive model of general applicability

To address a wider usability and impact across the European spectrum Sport as an educational tool: components as mentorship, skills, training, reflection and intervention are now inherent in the concept of ETS. Therefore, this educational model, following the framework of non-formal education [NFE], could be increasingly applied for various fields and purposes.

Sports Tourism

Sport as an accelerator for the development of the territory: encourage the teaching and dissemination of managerial models for the growth of sports tourism by focusing on the realization of major sporting events and the preservation of traditional games.

Sports tourism is one of the most demanded types of tourism. In particular, with the disappearance of borders, by making appropriate planning, almost everyone can participate in sports tourism organizations actively or as an audience. In the simplest terms, sports tourism can be defined as a type of tourism created by those who travel for the purpose of sporting activities (Alpull, Ak; 2018).

Aligned to the "<u>The HealthyLifestyle4All Initiative</u>" the European Commission wishes to involve sport movements at national, European and international level; state authorities (ministries), cities & regions (local governments) and civil society organisations.

Poster conditions

Maximum Poster-size: 100 cm wide x 175 cm high
